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Introduction

LouSSM Mission Statement

Core Values

❖ God is Good

- ❖ Jesus perfectly reveals the nature of God as a good Father. God is good regardless of our circumstances. God is generous, and as we remember and retell what He has done, He's able and eager to do it again.

❖ Salvation Creates Joyful Identity

- ❖ We are new creations, not merely "sinners saved by grace," but saints who have been given His righteousness. We are adopted as royalty into God's family.

❖ Responsive To Grace

- ❖ God scandalously loves His "lost" creation and extends grace, empowering believers to love Him and others at a higher standard than the law. Deeply experiencing grace enables us to walk out of shame and into righteousness.

❖ Focused On His Presence

- ❖ Our first ministry is to God. As a lifestyle, we focus on Him while we minister and attempt to say what God is saying and do what He is doing.

❖ Creating Healthy Family

- ❖ We are adopted into God's family, so we intentionally create family and community wherever we go. We think like healthy family members by doing what's best for the whole environment, submitting to one another, and living selflessly.

❖ God's Word Transforms

- ❖ When we encounter God in the Word, faith is released into our lives. As we study Scripture, it empowers us to learn who God is, who we are and how He wants us to live.

❖ God Is Still Speaking

- ❖ Jesus said that His sheep would know His voice and that the Holy Spirit would teach us all things. It's natural for God to communicate with His family and important for us to listen, learn His language, and test what we are hearing with Scripture.

❖ Jesus Empowers Supernatural Ministry

- ❖ Jesus promised signs would follow believers and that they would do even greater works than He. Nothing is impossible with God, so no person or situation is beyond His ability to bring complete restoration.

The thread of this generosity is woven throughout His creation, covenants, provision, the person of Jesus, and the Kingdom, as He consistently models that it is more blessed to give than to receive. God has blessed us in every way so that we can be generous in every way to advance the Gospel. Our generosity is a response to, and reflection of, Him.

School-Wide Structure & Expectations

Course Structure

- Classes will be held **1x/week**
- School-wide family gatherings occur **1x/month** and include a meal, fellowship, activations, prayer, etc.
- **1 additional meeting time/month** will be discussed and agreed upon within individual Revival Groups
- Individuals are responsible for **3 hrs of teaching/month** outside of class
 - Teachings will be posted on the school website (LouSSM.org) and can be viewed on individual schedules for 1st Year, 2nd Year, and 4th Year Students

Revival Groups

Students are placed into Revival Groups that are led by one of our Revival Group Pastors for the year. Revival Groups meet weekly to build community, discuss and impart core values and activate students in personal revival.

Attendance Policy

For the sake of maximizing individual learning and fostering growth as a community, **no more than 6 absences** are allowed over the course of the entire 33-week school year.

Honor System

Assignments are done on the “honor system” which is designed to do just that—build your honor. As such, students will learn to build their integrity one “yes,” one assignment, one check box at a time.

Topics Covered Throughout the Year

♦ IDENTITY

- The core objective of these teachings is to convince students of the “royalty” they possess as children of the King and mobilize them into the holy, supernatural lifestyle that flows from such a self-awareness.

♦ INTIMACY

- The core objective of these teachings is to guide students into deeper relationships with both God and people by revealing the depths of the Father’s love and equipping students with the knowledge of how to hear and interpret His voice.

♦ BIBLE

- The truth is that every reader of the Bible interprets it; the only question is whether or not you will be any good at it. These lessons are both an introduction and an equipping time so that students might accurately handle the Word of Truth. They are designed to help students examine and, if need be, alter the “lens” through which they interpret and experience Scripture.

♦ KINGDOM CULTURE

- Culture is the system of beliefs, disciplines, practices, and relational boundaries that reveal how life is lived among a particular group of people. Accordingly, movements of any kind succeed when they have created a culture that can sustain it. The purpose of this course is to cultivate a culture based on Kingdom values and principles in order to sustain the movement of God.

♦ SUPERNATURAL LIVING

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- The objective of these teachings is, firstly, to expand students' understanding of what is possible through the supernatural power of God and, secondly, to equip them with the practical tools necessary to operate in these supernatural giftings on a daily basis.

♦ LEADERSHIP

- The world's understanding of leadership is different from what the Bible says about it. Leadership is not about our position, title, how many people are under our authority, or what rules we are enforcing. Our objective is to teach students to become what the Bible defines leadership as: influence, service, guidance, and relationships. Jesus is our example of leadership.

♦ RELATIONSHIPS

- The goal of these teachings is to create powerful people determined to establish healthy, thriving relationships—relationships marked by loving connection, respectful communication, and well-defined boundaries.
